Instructions

Also, have your school send an official copy of your transcript through the end of the first semester of your senior year. If you are currently attending college, have the college records office send a transcript of all your college work to date (the college transcript would be in addition to the information sent from your high school).
- c. Have one of your teachers and another person familiar with your qualifications write a letter of recommendation. These letters should be sent from the recommender directly to the Dean of the School of Accountancy at The University of Mississippi.
- d. Write a one-page summary telling why you want to major in accounting and how one of these scholarships would be beneficial to you in preparing for your career.
