

Applicants who have not completed the GRE within the past 5 years are required to take the GRE and submit official score reports to the Graduate School. The doctoral program in Counselor Education requires official verbal, quantitative, and writing scores to reach a decision about admission to the program.

The University of Mississippi Division of Outreach and Continuing Education administers computer based GRE's. Applicants who take the computer based GRE get verbal and quantitative scores immediately after completing the exam. Official scores are sent to the Graduate School in 2 to 3 weeks after the examination date. The program will consider the reports given to applicants immediately after the computer based exam to facilitate the application process, but cannot make a formal recommendation to the Graduate School until the official scores are on file in the Graduate School.

The GRE may be scheduled on Monday through Friday on a space available basis. The cost of the GRE is \$120.00. Call 662 915-6501 to schedule an appointment.
