



Lower Division Requirements For a Bachelor of Arts Degree (For Students Graduating December 2006 and Afterwards)

◆ **English** (12 hours required)

Composition (6 hours): ENGL 101 and either ENGL 102 or LIBA 102
Literature (6 hours): ENGL 221, 222, 223, 224, 225, or 226

◆ **Modern or Ancient Language** (6 hours at sophomore (200) level or above)

From Department of Modern Languages: Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese,
Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish.
From Department of Classics: Ancient Greek and Latin.

◆ **Mathematics** (3 hours required)

Math 110, 115, 121, 123, 125, 261, 262, 267, 268

◆ **Fine Arts** (3 hours required)

Art History (any AH course)	Music 101, 102, 103, 104, 105
Theatre 201	Dance 200

◆ **Social Science** (6 hours required)

Both courses may be in the same area or two different areas may be chosen. Choose courses from the following areas:

Anthropology	Political Science
Economics	Psychology
Journalism 101	Sociology

◆ **History** (6 hours required)

◆ **Humanities** (3 hours required)

African American Studies (any AAS course)	Religion (any REL course)
Classical Civilization (any CLC course)	Southern Studies 101, 102
Gender Studies 103, 201, 311, 333, 390	University Honors 101, 102
Philosophy (any PHIL course)	

◆ **Natural Science** (3 science courses required, of which 2 must have labs; 9-11 total hours required)

Two of the courses **must be** in the same department:

- (A) Astronomy or Physics or Physical Science
- (B) Biology
- (C) Chemistry
- (D) Geology

Note: If you choose to take two courses from Area A, then you must take two courses in Astronomy or two courses in Physics or two courses in Physical Science.

TOTAL HOURS 126 earned hours are required for a B.A. degree

UPPER DIVISION HOURS 42 hours at the 300 level or above are required for a B.A. degree

GRADE POINTS AND GRADE POINT AVERAGES

- ◆ A 2.00 grade point average (GPA) must be earned in all work submitted in fulfillment of degree requirements
- ◆ An overall GPA of 2.00 or higher is required in work applied toward the major
- ◆ An overall GPA of 2.00 or higher is required in work applied toward the minor.
- ◆ For purposes of GPA, residence work is considered separately from transfer work.
