

# ***Eudora SSL Certificates***

The instructions below will demonstrate how to make the appropriate changes to your e-mail client program. If you have difficulty, please contact the IT Helpdesk at 662-915-5222.

**Please note** that your e-mail application may be a different version than appears in the screen shots on this webpage. There are a number of issues with old versions of Eudora so the IT Helpdesk recommends Eudora users' upgrade to the latest version – the IT Helpdesk cannot guarantee support for Eudora 5 or earlier.

**Step 1:** Open Eudora, then navigate to the “Tools” menu, and choose “Options”.

**Step 2:** Select the “Checking Mail” category in the left hand pane of the window.

**Step 3:** In the box labeled “Secure Sockets when Receiving” choose the “Last SSL Info” button.

**Step 4:** Click on “Certificate Information Manager”, above the “Ok” button.

**Step 5:** Choose the “Add to Trusted” button.

**Step 6:** Click “Done”

**Step 7:** Click “Ok”

**Step 8:** Click “Ok” again

**Step 9:** Exit and restart Eudora
