



## Lower Division Requirements For a Bachelor of Arts Degree

### Fall 2009 Undergraduate Catalog

◆ **English** (12 hours required)

Composition (6 hours): ENGL 101, and either ENGL 102 or LIBA 102  
Literature (6 hours): ENGL 221, 222, 223, 224, 225, or 226

◆ **Modern or Ancient Language** (6 hours at 200-level or above)

From Department of Modern Languages: Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish  
From Department of Classics: Ancient Greek and Latin

◆ **Mathematics** (3 hours required)

Students may take any MATH course at the 100-level or above except for MATH 245 and 246.

◆ **Fine Arts** (3 hours required)

Art History (any AH course)	Music 101, 102, 103, 104, 105
Theatre 201	Dance 200

◆ **Social Science** (6 hours required)

Anthropology	Political Science	Sociology
Economics	Psychology	

◆ **History** (6 hours required)

Students may take any HIS course; freshmen students may not register for courses at the 300-level or above.

- **Additional Humanities** (3 hours required)

African American Studies (any AAS course)

Classical Civilization (any CLC course)

\*Gender Studies 103, 201, 301, 333

Philosophy (any PHIL course)

Religion (any REL course)

Southern Studies 101, 102

University Honors 101, 102

Environmental Studies (ENVS) 101

\*In addition, gender studies courses that are cross-listed with African American studies, classical civilization, English, modern languages, philosophy, or religion courses will satisfy this requirement.

- ◆ **Natural Science** (3 science courses required, of which 2 must have labs; 9-11 total hours required)

Two of the courses **must be** in the same area of science:

1. Astronomy or Physics or Physical Science
2. Biology
3. Chemistry
4. Geology

Note: If you choose to take two courses from Area 1, then you must take two courses in Astronomy or two courses in Physics or two courses in Physical Science.

**TOTAL HOURS** 124 earned hours are required for a B.A. degree beginning Fall 2007  
**UPPER DIVISION HOURS** 42 hours at the 300 level or above are required for a B.A. degree

### **GRADE POINTS AND GRADE POINT AVERAGES**

- ◆ A 2.00 grade point average (GPA) must be earned in all work submitted in fulfillment of degree requirements
- ◆ An overall GPA of 2.00 or higher is required in work applied toward the major
- ◆ An overall GPA of 2.00 or higher is required in work applied toward the minor.
- ◆ For purposes of GPA, residence work is considered separately from transfer work.
