



## Lower Division Requirements For a Bachelor of Science Degree

### Fall 2009 Undergraduate Catalog

◆ **English** (12 hours required)

Composition (6 hours): ENGL 101, and either ENGL 102 or LIBA 102

Literature (6 hours): ENGL 221, 222, 223, 224, 225, or 226

◆ **Modern or Ancient Language** (6 hours at 200-level or above)

From Department of Modern Languages: Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish

From Department of Classics: Ancient Greek and Latin

◆ **Social Science and Humanities** (12 total hours required; six hours must be chosen in one subject, with the remaining six hours in a different subject or subjects)

◆ **Fine Arts** (3 hours)

Art History (any AH course)

◆ **Major** (choose from Biology, Chemistry, Forensic Chemistry, Geology, Mathematics, Physics)

A minimum of 42 hours in major required. See catalog for required courses for major.

◆ **Related Subjects** (18 hours required; choose from courses listed below)

<u>Major</u>	<u>Related Subjects</u>
Biology	anthropology, chemistry, geology, mathematics, physics, psychology
Chemistry	mathematics, physics
Forensic Chemistry	biology, mathematics, pharmacology, physics; up to 6 hours of pharmacology courses may be used
Geology	biology, chemistry, computer science, mathematics, physics
Mathematics	astronomy, biology, chemistry, computer science, economics, geology, physics
Physics	mathematics

**Total Hours** 124 earned hours are required for a B.S. degree beginning Fall 2007  
**Upper Division Hours** 42 hours at the 300-level or above are required for a B.S. degree

**Grade Points and Grade Point Averages**

- A 2.00 grade point average (GPA) must be earned for all work submitted in fulfillment of degree requirements
- An overall GPA of at least 2.00 is required in work applied toward the major.
- An overall GPA of 2.00 is required in the 18 hour group of related subjects.
- An overall GPA of 2.00 is required in the 18 hour group of non-related subjects.
- For purposes of GPA, residence work is considered separately from transfer work.
