

# Major Construction Areas Affecting Traffic-Parking-Pedestrian Flow Summer 2016 (updated May 5th)

**Other Major Projects (more than 6 months remaining):**  
 Alpha Phi Construction  
 Chi Psi Construction  
 Garland-Hedleston-Mays Renovations  
 Johnson Commons East Renovations  
 Gillom Center Renovations

**Residential Parking Garage:**  
 Phase I has begun and will include a new access road to the Upper Kincannon Parking Lot. Phase II will begin in May with project completion scheduled before the start of the Fall 2017 Semester.

**Student Union Expansion/Renovations:**  
 Construction is well underway on the new section of the Student Union building. Work in this area will continue for several more years. Expect traffic delays and occasional road closures due to materials and equipment deliveries.

**STEM Building Construction Site:**  
 Work started this past semester and is expected to continue through next year on the new STEM academic building. Expect occasional traffic impacts on All American Drive due to materials deliveries and the expansion or connections made to subsurface utilities.

**University Avenue Bridge Retrofit:**  
 The University Avenue bridge crossing Gertrude Ford is in need of retrofits to maintain its load carrying capacity. Work is slated to begin this summer and will result in the temporary closure of Gertrude Ford Blvd. and the reduction of University Ave. traffic to two lanes. Duration 4-6 weeks from start.

**North End Zone and Southern Drainage Projects:**  
 These two projects are expected to continue to impact parking and transit throughout the area around the north side of Vaught-Hemmingway Stadium. Project completion is expected by start of the Fall Semester.

**Practice Fields and Track Renovations:**  
 Both the rebuild of the track and field facility grounds and the football practice field's construction will continue through the early part of the summer. Completion is expected by start of the Fall semester.

**Turner Center Parking Lot Resurfacing:**  
 The two lots around the Turner Center that were used heavily during The Pavilion construction will be resurfaced and restriped this summer. Closure notices will be posted close to project start.

**New Residence Halls 2 and 3:**  
 Work will continue on RH2 and RH3 throughout the summer. Both halls will be open for the start of the Fall semester. Expect occasional traffic delays for materials and equipment delivery.

**Rebel Drive / Guyton Drive Changes:**  
 Expected May 16th, the 3-way stop sign at Guyton Drive and Fraternity Row will move to Fraternity Row and West Road. Guyton Drive will no longer connect to Fraternity Row. New stop signs will be installed at Rebel Drive and Fraternity Row and at the Rebel Drive and the north entrance to Guyton Drive and the new drive going to the rear of Kinard.

**Chucky Mullins Utility Installation/Paving:**  
 Starting May 16th, Chucky Mullins will be closed to through traffic for the installation of subsurface utilities. Shortly after, the work will progress to Fraternity Row resulting in its closure. All traffic should use West Road or other routes to avoid the closures. Once utilities are in place, the road will be resurfaced. Expected completion – Mid-July.
